FAO approves creation of the International Day of Fruits and Vegetables, to be adopted by the UN in September 2025: WUWM and AIAM5 Proudly Supported the Initiative from the Start

In addition, the topic was a highlight of discussions during the **WUWM General Assembly held on November 1, 2024**, where members expressed strong support for global efforts to raise awareness of the vital role fruits and vegetables play in our diets and economies.
